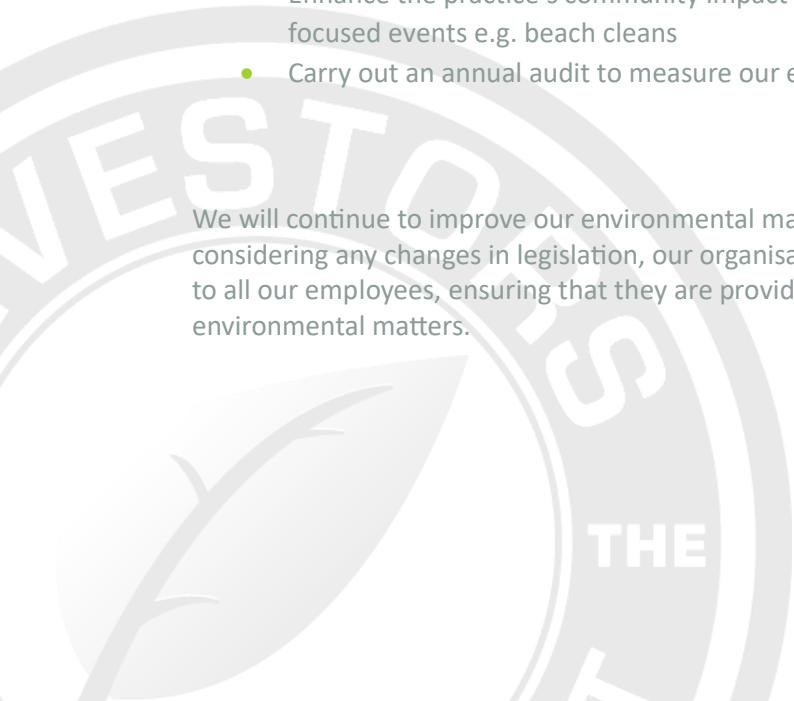
- Consumption of electricity, gas, water, and other fuels

- Waste generation
- Transport emissions
- Use of raw materials, including prescribed drugs and medicines
- Procured goods and services with their own environmental impact

Westover Vets is committed to reducing its environmental impact through a journey of continual improvement by working through the Investors in the Environment (iiE) accreditation scheme. Our commitment to the environment allows us to minimise our carbon footprint, whilst maintaining a high-quality service for our patients and a safe and healthy working environment for our employees.

Our environmental commitment can be demonstrated in our established objectives and goals below:

- Implement a waste/recycling policy and sustainable procurement policy to minimise our waste production and ensure it is disposed of correctly
- Monitor our key resource usage and implement conservation techniques to achieve our environmental targets
- Commitment to a 2% reduction in electricity and water usage over the next year
- Compliance with all applicable environmental regulations and public/customer expectations
- Minimise unsustainable transport e.g. by encouraging car shares
- Enhance the practice's community impact by engaging in community projects and green-focused events e.g. beach cleans
- Carry out an annual audit to measure our environmental impact

We will continue to improve our environmental management system by working to iiE criteria, considering any changes in legislation, our organisation, and other factors. We will convey this policy to all our employees, ensuring that they are provided with training to increase awareness of environmental matters.
