Your pet will need to continue this medication / food until it is finished unless otherwise directed by your vet.

If your pet has stitches they will need to rest and have restricted exercise. Dogs should be restricted to lead exercise only to allow urination and defecation. Cats should be confined indoors and provided with a litter tray. You will be provided with an Elizabethan ("Buster") collar for your pet to wear, it is best if this is worn all the time, to stop them interfering with their stitches/wound.
